- 1. Ciaran Lyons, *Laughs for Lifeline Comedy Gala*, Seymour Centre (\$45,800)** — Two stand-up comedy events featuring Australia's biggest and best comedians, to promote a charity and provide employment for stand-up comedians following a hard year of little work in the comedy sector.
- 2. Circus Monoxide Precarious Inc, *Off Axis*, Darling Harbour (\$50,000)**— Circus Monoxide will present multiple 30-minute public performances in Darling Harbour. Eight circus artists will perform outdoor on a mobile cube sculpture - dancing, tumbling, and contorting through it. Audiences will enjoy a fun circus street party accompanied by a live DJ.
- 3. Emma Fielden, *Andromeda and The Milky Way + The Bells*, 812B George Street, Haymarket (\$34,616)** — Over four weeks at 812B George Street Haymarket, an exhibition of artworks by Emma Fielden will be on show, and will include a series of live performances of *Andromeda and The Milky Way* and *The Bells* as well as immersive installations.
- 4. Edward Lyons, *End Notes: Disco Paradiso*, Beresford Hotel (\$15,000)** — *End Notes* will deliver one of Sydney's highest quality live band nights featuring ensembles of up to 12 band members performing contemporary reinterpretations of funk, afrobeat, jazz and Latin classics.
- 5. Music and Booze Company, *King Street Crawl*, King St Newtown (\$50,000)** — *The King Street Crawl* is an annual musical crawl up and down King Street Newtown. For one day the event will activate the array of venues and spaces along this famous strip, in a celebration of live music and the Inner West's creative diverse communities.
- 6. Sarah Bedak-Radic, *Lolo Lovina, Marsala and the Caravan Stage*, The Rocks (\$10,000)** — *Lolo Lovina, Marsala and the Caravan Stage* is a collaboration between two of Sydney's most well-known World Music bands. *Lolo the Caravan Stage* will perform in North George St, The Rocks, drawing bands and new audiences to the central business district of Sydney.
- 7. Stu Hunter, *The Wednesday HOTSPOT! live @ LOWER BAR*, Tattersalls Club Sydney (\$24,000)** — A 12-week series of live performances at City Tattersalls Club Sydney each Wednesday across three months in 2021. These events will provide performing opportunities for some of Sydney's best contemporary musicians to develop new music for audiences and grow a new following into the future.
- 8. The Event Space, *Barangaroo Delicious Month Out*, Barangaroo Dining Precinct (\$47,275)** — *Barangaroo Delicious Month Out* will showcase a series of roving entertainment weaving through the dining precincts of Barangaroo, creating a joyful carnival atmosphere and to encourage increased footfall to local businesses during the month-long event. The entertainment will range from brass bands, acoustic performers, and LED acts. The event will support local hospitality businesses and artists as they rebuild following the uncertainty and upheaval of 2020.
- 9. The Event Space, *Sounds in the Square*, Darling Square (\$50,000)** — *Sounds in the Square* will be a series of curated live music performances throughout June. With a custom-made 'Tipi' as the performance stage and creating a Spiegeltent vibe within Darling Square.
- 10. Third Person Management, Jarryd James Live, George St Cinemas Sydney (\$36,800)** — Jarryd James, an ARIA Award-winning multi-platinum artist, will play with his band at Event

Cinemas George Street, in surround sound using the existing 7.1 Dolby Atmos speakers, to create custom made visuals to show on the screens during this once in a lifetime live show.
