

Create NSW Service Needs Strategic Funding 2020/21 recipients

Six projects funded in total at \$388,354 over three years.

- **Australian Theatre for Young People, *Youth Arts Sector National Connections* (\$59,000 in total for one year)** – In 2022, Australian Theatre Young People (ATYP) will host the Youth Arts Sector National Connections Summit over three days at their new bespoke venue on Pier 2/3. With support from Create NSW, ATYP will ensure that youth arts representatives from across the country can attend and be featured online via ATYP On Demand Plus.
- **Dance Makers Collective Incorporated, *Make It Happen - Skills Development Program for Freelance Artists* (\$59,412 in total over three years)** – *Make It Happen* is a series of programs and resources designed to enable artists to realise projects. The series involves face-to-face and digital course work and resources covering areas such as: entrepreneurship, project management, market research/marketing and stakeholder development. The program is delivered in partnership with Councils across Western Sydney.
- **Diversity Arts Australia, *Culture Change: Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Capacity Building Program* (\$75,000 in total for one year)** – *Culture Change* is a capacity building program aimed at supporting organisations in their diversity, equity, and inclusion objectives. This program will be delivered to 8 NSW-based organisations and will focus on systemic change in cultural and linguistic diversity, cultural safety, and intersectionality.
- **Studio A Limited, *Rights Animated* (\$40,000 in total for one year)** – *Rights Animated* addresses the critical gap in legal rights information accessible to artists with intellectual disability and/or literacy challenges. Graphic animations created by Studio A artist, Greg Sindel based on Arts Law's legal expertise will build capacity of artists to understand, protect and gain economic benefit from their creative practice.
- **The CAD Factory, *The Contemporary Art Socially Engaged, CASE Incubator* (\$124,942 in total over two years)** – The *CASE Incubator* is aimed at socially engaged artists undertaking professional development, engaging with their peers, creating networking opportunities with diverse partners, contributing back to the sector, and establishing processes of care.
- **WestWords Ltd, *Western Sydney Academy of Writers* (\$30,000 in total for one year)** – The Academy is a career developmental program for emerging writers to provide mentorship to hone their craft, create work, develop projects, seek opportunities, and realise sustainable career pathways.
